The committee reserve the right to change or cancel any class or classes.

Objections must be lodged within 10 minutes of the incident concerned, with a £10 deposit, returnable if the objection is upheld. .

Riders will be banned from the showground for misuse of whips, spurs or for behaviour which is detrimental to the show.

No sticks or spurs are permitted in gymkhana events.

Hard hats and sensible footwear must be worn at all times.

No galloping outside the ring.

No Stallions on the show field

Ages as day of show: Competitors may compete in any class HC, but please notify judge on entering the ring.

No child under 2 years of age to be mounted on the show field.

No horse under 4 years of age to be ridden on the show field
